He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall;

but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength.

They will soar on wings like eagles, they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint.

Isaiah 40:29-31

Dear praying friends,

When I was young, the meaning of this passage seemed very clear to me. I understood it in the sense that it is fine to wear out oneself to the point of exhaustion and beyond. After all, if you trust God, you will always receive new strength. Unfortunately, this attitude is causing many Christian ministry workers to break down both physically and mentally, and sometimes even spiritually.

Today I read the passage differently. It can be misleading if we read it without context, as a slightly different picture emerges from the verses preceding the ones we have just read. The passage is referring to a time when the Israelites were captives in Babylonia, running the risk of losing their identity as a people. They felt abandoned and forgotten by God. They had really reached the end of the line and were running on empty. They did not know if they would survive as a people and whether the promises God had given to their forefathers would ever be fulfilled.

But God wants to encourage his people by reminding them that he is still the same. "O Jacob, how can you say the Lord does not see your troubles? O Israel, how can you say God ignores your rights? Have you never heard? Have you never understood? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of all the earth. He never grows weak or weary. No one can measure the depths of his understanding" (Isaiah 40:27-28).

Because the eternal God has strength and power and is full of mercy, even weak and tired people who are at their wits end can receive new strength. In the case of the Israelites, it was the necessary spark of hope and trust that God would carry them through the dry land of captivity until they would get back into their homeland. In our case, it may be the weariness of old age, the pressure of financial challenges, the pain of serving amongst people who are hostile or indifferent to the Gospel, or it might be a new Covid wave. We may be tired and weary of all of this, but God never grows weak and weary. And he has promised to give us new strength in hard times when we trust in him.

One of my favourite theologians is Dietrich Bonhoeffer. He wrote in one of his letters from prison: "I believe that God can and will let good come out of everything, even the greatest evil. For that to happen, God needs human beings who let everything work out for the best. I believe that in every moment of distress God will give us as much strength to resist as we need. But it is not given to us in advance, lest we rely on ourselves and not on God alone. In such faith all fear of the future should be overcome."

Thank you for praying for our brothers and sisters around the world, who may be a bit weary at this moment.

Pray for our online preaching on church pages and YouTube Channel and for our online Bible ministry training for our volunteers in local churches.


13-19 SEPTEMBER
