Dear praying friends,

Amazing, isn't it? The apostle Paul is asking the Christians in Rome to participate in his ministry, who are - with a few exceptions - complete strangers to him. As he is travelling from place to place to preach the good news of Jesus, he relies on the Christian church in Rome to do their part in the Great Commission.

His ministry was not very easy. The number of Christians was vanishingly small. There were not people joyfully accepting the Good News everywhere. There was criticism, resistance, hostility, and sometimes personal disappointment. Basically, the situation Paul found about 2000 years ago was hardly different from what some of our SU teams are experiencing today.

So how did Paul deal with this situation? He asked the Christians in Rome for prayer support. He told them: "Listen, I really need you guys. Yes, we are separated by more than 2000 kilometres, but because we are members of the body of Christ together and connected through the Holy Spirit, you can help me. The distance is not an issue at all. We don't have email, telephone, and airplanes yet. But there is still much you can do."

For Paul, collaboration in the Great Commission by prayer is taking part in a spiritual battle. The Bible makes it very clear that God's adversary, Satan, is doing everything he can to prevent the Kingdom of God from growing. Ministry workers can easily get tired, discouraged, beaten, or hurt. That is why it is important to know: I am part of a larger team. My team may not be physically near, but we are connected through the Holy Spirit. I am not fighting alone. In South Africa, Vietnam, Germany, the UK or wherever else – I have brothers and sisters who are fighting with me.

The SUI Global Prayer News is a regular and constant invitation to step up in prayer for the global ministry of Scripture Union. However, every year in November we take some extra time for prayer. To connect with each more intentionally. To listen to God together and pray.

I would like to invite you to reserve the first full week of November as a movement or as individuals and to join our global prayer events. Because we need each other!

This year our Global Week of Prayer, will explore the book of Zechariah and what it means to be 'prisoners of hope' (Zech 9:12). What does this ancient book have to say about this present moment? Zechariah is a book rich with imagery, some of it quite unusual and confronting! This book seeks to help the community of Israel to look beyond their exile and captivity towards the fulfilment of the Kingdom of God. The prophet calls them to repentance and a renewed commitment to their covenant with God. He describes a vision of all that God has in store for the community of faith. There is much in this book for us to explore and find inspiration in as we gather to pray.

We particularly invite you to read and meditate on Chapter 8 and the wonderful vision that God lays before His people. Picture the streets filled once again with old men and women. Hear the children playing. Watch people coming from the East and West, a multitude of languages and nations, living in faithfulness and righteousness. Crops growing and vines laden with fat, juicy grapes.

What a wonderful vision to be captured by!

Zechariah calls the people to be 'prisoners of hope', a juxtaposition of terms. It is a great way to think about how we are to live. Bound by hope, captured by hope, inspired to live with a 'lock us up and throw away the key' kind of hope.

As we gather to pray for what God has done over the past year and look ahead to what God will do in the future, we can be people of hope. We can look above the chaos and look forward to the coming of the Kingdom and God's ultimate restoration.

#### 1-3 OCTOBER

#### □ Scripture Union International

The third in a series of six Bible Engagement Round Tables will take place today. Pray that there will be robust discussions that would help us to rethink and reimagine Bible Engagement across the SU Global Family.

#### ☐ Scripture Union International

The Global Board will be meeting from 1-3 October. It was planned to be in France so time could be taken to get to know the new members of the Board, but it will now be held virtually due to ongoing travel difficulties and restrictions. Pray there will be bonding and unity, despite the physical distance between members.

#### ☐ Russia

Praise God for the Teens' camp we had 13-15 August. We went kayaking on the river, read the Gospel, talked about Jesus and Peter, cooked food on fire and learned to cope with the difficulties together.

#### ☐ Germany

During the summer we were able to carry out some beach outreaches and some camps despite the pandemic. We are grateful for God's protection for our activities and staff, even during the flood disaster we experienced.

#### □ Tonga

We request your prayers for our Annual Camp and for our Campsite project.

#### □ New Zealand

Please pray for 'Pōnui Spring Adventure', a new SUNZ intermediate-age camp running from 6-9 October and for our Team Leader. The camp is the first of new camps designed to help bridge the gap between SUNZ children's camps and SUNZ youth camps.

#### ☐ Estonia

We are grateful for the blessed camps this summer: for the window opened in COVID-19 regulations that allowed us to hold events for almost 400 campers - whose lives were changed. #### □ Austria

In between 12-14 October the three Directors of the German speaking SU movements will meet for ministry updates. Please pray that this gathering will encourage and strengthen our partnership and help with our projects.

#### □ Serbia

Please pray for the activities we are planning to do in the autumn and for the Lord to give us wisdom regarding the changes that come with COVID-19 measures. Please pray for the seminar that is planned for October. We would like to encourage our volunteers to take care of themselves while serving others.



#### □ Northern Ireland

#### GLOBAL WEEK OF PRAYER



#### □ Launch Event

Join us at our 90-minute launch event for the annual Global Week of Prayer. Pray that as we gather, we might all become inspired and engaged for the week ahead. 7 November at 7:00 pm London time – sign up <a href="here">here</a>

#### ☐ Day 1— Repentance

- Pray together, focusing on what repentance looks like for your movement and for SU around the world.
- Spend time lamenting what has been lost or that grieves you, your movement and SU around the world. Commit these to God.
- Listen to what God is prompting you about for the future. What are the opportunities to be found in a new direction? Ask God for wisdom and courage to discern the way ahead and step into it.

#### □ Day 2 – Reliance

Pray together for where you can see the walls broken down and in need of repair. What might it look like to experience God's protection and indwelling in each of these places:

- The impact on nations of COVID-19, civil war or natural disasters.
- The rebuilding of communities impacted by violence or apathy.
- Families torn apart by poverty or neglect.
- Churches that have been stunned into silence with the closing of their doors.
- The ministries of Scripture Union that have ceased or been severely impacted by the events of this year.

Pray together for God's direction as to how to respond to each of these seemingly overwhelming realities. Consider what it means to see God's Kingdom reigning from a global perspective and pray the Lord's prayer together - Your Kingdom come!

#### ☐ Day 3 – Renewal

- Pray for the leaders in your SU movement and your local church, considering Zechariah 3&4.
   Pray the words of 4:6 for them, that they will rely not on their own strength, but on the Holy Spirit.
- Although we may feel like the 'day of small things' (4:10) describes our ministry, pray for a sense of God at work and a renewed perspective on the local and global ministry of SU
- Spend time as individuals focusing on Psalm 139:23-24 and the image of taking off the filthy clothes to dress anew in God's garments.

#### ☐ Day 4 – Restoration

Consider how our churches and communities of faith can best reflect what it means to belong to the Kingdom of God. Spend some time praying about what restoration might look like practically in each of the following areas. Respond to what God might be saying to your SU movement about your role in this.

- Acting with justice and mercy
- Loving your neighbour
- Showing compassion
- Not taking advantage of the vulnerable
- Not plotting and scheming against each other.

#### □ Day 5 – Rejoicing

- Oppression, injustice, war that God would bring peace.
- Read 9:14-17 and use these words to create a prayer for the children and young people you minister with.
- 10:6-7 paints a picture of renewed communities, where children flourish in faith. Rejoice together for the lives of children and young people who have been transformed by the good news of Jesus. Take this opportunity to pray for movements who work with displaced children and young people - that the good news will help them thrive, not just survive.
- Pray for SU as a global movement, that we would live out being 'prisoners of hope' in such a way that people will be drawn to God and His Kingdom.

#### ☐ 24-Hour Day of Prayer

Join us as SUI hosts 24 hours of prayer from around the world. Pray that the technology all works and that we can share in a tremendous time of prayer and celebration. Starts 13 November at 6:00am Auckland time—sign up **here**
