When your words came, I ate them; they were my joy and my heart's delight, for I bear your name, Lord God Almighty. Jeremiah 15:16

Dear friends and prayer partners,

Looking ahead into 2022, many of us are feeling nervous. The challenges and disruptions of the pandemic are not over yet. The aftereffects of two years of 'stop-and-go' ministry are concerning. Churches have shrunk in size and children and young people are struggling with mental health issues. Many are grieving the loss of loved ones, and we all are tired of the restrictions and feel unable to bear yet another year of pain and constraints. So why did I choose the verse from Jeremiah about joy and delight?

In the context of Jeremiah 15, this verse is like a bright flashlight in the gloom and darkness. Jeremiah talks about God's judgement on his people, about pain, shame, fear, and death. He is frustrated by the message he is called to share; and the people around him hate him for speaking out. But then there is this one verse that brings light on to the scene. God's words are Jeremiah's joy and his heart's delight. And even though his own people treat him like an enemy, he knows his true identity: He belongs to the Lord God Almighty!

Johann Hinrich Wichern, a German theologian and social reformer, once formulated a short 'prophecy' for the new year. Among other things, it contains this prediction: "Whoever lets his Bible gather dust from January 1 will find his soul dusty on December 31. But whoever searches the Bible for sources of life from January 1 will have bright eyes and a joyful heart on December 31. The new year will fly by like a cloud, and before it is over, many a one who greeted January 1 cheerfully will lie between five boards and two planks and be carried out by men in black suits. But the grace and mercy of God will remain beyond the new year, that is, from eternity to eternity."

In a world full of distractions, it is not easy to really focus on God's word – not even for fulltime SU staff workers. But let us learn to dive deep into the Word together; to challenge and comfort each other with the Word; and to invite children, young people, and families to discover the joy and delight and the deep sense of belonging and identity it brings to those who 'eat' the Word - especially in difficult and gloomy times.

We welcome **Hakon Christensen** who has been appointed as the new National Leader for SU Denmark. Hakon lives in Hillerød with his wife Ulla, who is a teacher. They have three grown up children.

He says "My own enthusiasm and joy for the Bible is primarily due to a belief that the Bible is the word of God, and an experience that God himself is near to me through the words of the Bible. The Bible is simply alive in a way."

I think SU has a good logo. If you are in doubt, then sit in a quiet place and look at it for five minutes. The logo is a stylized oil lamp. Notice that the flame never goes out... that is because the lamp illustrates the words of Psalm 119:105 *"Your words are a lamp to my feet and a light for my path".* The word of God always shines. And the light is Jesus. The New Testament tells us that He *"is the light of the world"* (John 8:12)."

I think SU Denmark will continue to be a small, but extremely important, piece in the great ecclesiastical landscape. Others work on the same vision, but as far as I can see, it is a gift to the church in Denmark that SU DK in a special way - and continuously - focuses on the regular use of the Bible and develops resources that can support this. Long live - the joy of the Bible!"

Eunice says "I was born into a Christian family and accepted the Lord Jesus as my personal Saviour at the age of 14. When I was 19, I made a commitment to serve among children. I became a teacher and served as an SU volunteer in my free time.



I married a full-time servant of God in Scripture Union and soon after our marriage I decided to also partner as a full-time volunteer as the field was in great need and I felt the Lord reminding me of my commitment. I expressed my desire to serve full time in Scripture Union and I praise God that SU was kind enough to appoint me as a full-time field staff in 1997. In 2017 I was promoted to Field Secretary for the Trichy central area TN. In December 2020, I was invited to the SU Chennai head office to serve as the Interim National Director.

I have two sons. The older one is married and blessed with a daughter and the younger one is pursuing his master's in theology. Praise be to God for this journey through which I tasted that He is always good."

1-2 JANUARY

□ Denmark
